What is CAMS?

The Court of Appeal Management System (CAMS) includes a comprehensive case and document management system and an electronic filing system. For litigants and lawyers, the benefits of CAMS include:

- Increased accessibility to the Court;
- The ability to file documents remotely from office or home at any time;
- The elimination of paper copies of all documents, which includes appeal records, factums, case authorities and Extracts of Key Evidence;
- The ability to access full case information at any time online and view the full text of all filed documents; and
- The ability to electronically receive notices, correspondence, and judgments from the Court.

Account Setup

Learn how to become a CAMS registered user and discuss how to set up a law firm administrator account, which grants the ability to manage the creation of new accounts and share electronic access to appeals with other lawyers and staff across your firm.

Accessing "My Appeals"

Discover how to electronically access the entire contents of the court file along with information about the parties, counsel of record, the order, judgment or decision under appeal, hearing dates, outcomes, filing deadlines, and more.

Filing Electronic Documents & Online Payment of Filing Fees
