**CRIMINAL CODE S.525 DETENTION REVIEW PROCESS
NEW FORMS CC4 and CC5**

In order to better align the Court's detention review process under s.525 of the *Criminal Code* with the decision of the Supreme Court of Canada in *R v Myers*, 2019 SCC 18, the Court of Queen's Bench has amended its Criminal Forms CC4 and CC5.
